Influenza Deaths in the District

KEARNEY – The Two Rivers Public Health Department is announcing the confirmation of an adult influenza death within the Two Rivers District – Buffalo, Dawson, Franklin, Gosper, Harlan, Kearney, Phelps counties. DHHS has reported 2 adult influenza related death in the TRPHD district (Buffalo, Dawson, Franklin, Gosper, Harlan, Kearney, & Phelps counties) this Flu season as of February 25th, 2025.

Even though Influenza A incidence continue to drop, the number of positive Influenza A cases is still over 150% of the previous year's rates. The best way to prevent influenza is to get vaccinated. TRPHD offers Influenza Vaccinations at all clinics. To schedule your Flu shot today 888-669-7154.

WHEN TO SEE A DOCTOR – Most people who get the flu can treat themselves at home and often don't need to see a healthcare professional. If you have emergency symptoms of the flu, get medical care right away.

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Chest pain
- Ongoing dizziness
- Seizures
- Worsening of existing medical conditions
- Severe weakness or muscle pain
- Gray or blue, lips or nail beds
- Dehydration
