## Two Additional COVID-19 Deaths in District

KEARNEY – Two Rivers Public Health Department is announcing the deaths of two additional community members due to complications related to COVID-19 during the 2025-2026 respiratory season, bringing the total to three. Our sympathies go out to the family and friends of the deceased during this difficult time. TRPHD is closely monitoring all respiratory infections, including influenza and RSV.

The individuals were residents of the 7-county Two Rivers Public Health Department District. Out of respect for privacy and in accordance with health information regulations, no further details about the individuals will be released at this time.

This tragic loss is a somber reminder of the importance of taking precautions during the current respiratory season. All residents are urged to:

- Stay up to date on influenza and COVID-19 vaccinations and boosters
- Practice good hand hygiene
- Stay home and get tested if you experience symptoms
