



## COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Dispensed in Two Rivers Health District (by County) : Dec 15 – Mar 22

The three graphs depict the current status of COVID-19 vaccination in Two Rivers Public Health District (TRPHD) as of March 16, 2021. This includes residents of Buffalo, Dawson, Franklin, Gosper, Harlan, Kearney & Phelps counties (97,132)

- Graphs 1 & 2 show relative number of **residents of each county** who have received one or two shots of the vaccine.
  - **Graph 1** shows the number of **eligible persons (16 + years)** per county, and orders the counties by decreasing percentage of persons who received one or two doses of the vaccine.
  - **Graph 2** shows the number of persons **aged 65+ years** in the district, and orders each county by decreasing percentage of persons who received one dose and those fully vaccinated.
- **Graph 3** shows the doses provided in Two Rivers Health District by county.
- **Graph 4** describes the daily count of TRPHD residents who are fully vaccinated.

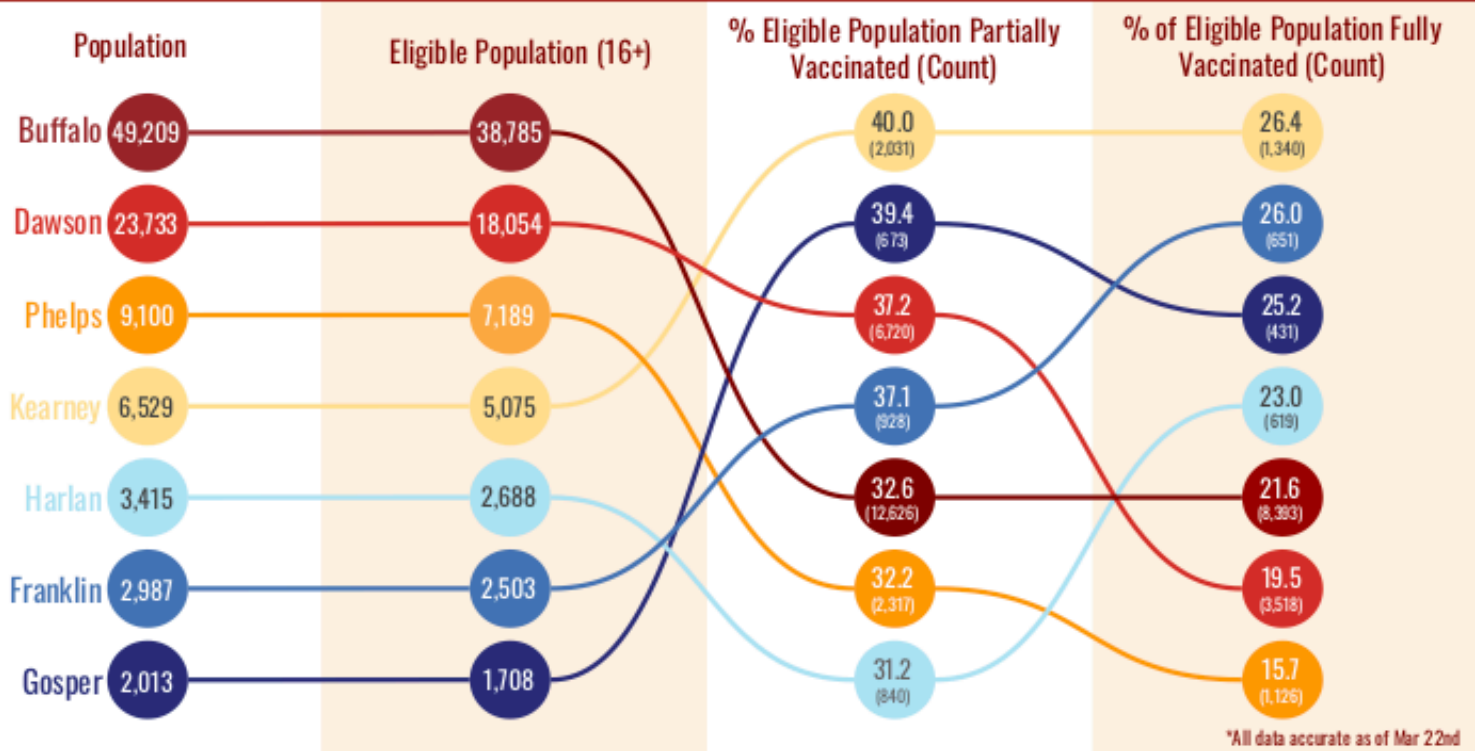
### Key Takeaways

1. *Among Health Departments in Nebraska, TRPHD has vaccinated the highest proportion of its eligible population; as of March 23, over 21% of the district's eligible population had been fully vaccinated. This continues to be higher than the Statewide average.*
2. *Roughly a fifth of the doses provided by TRPHD have gone to residents outside of the seven counties in the health district. There seems to be some degree of reciprocity with other health districts, roughly 9% of TRPHD residents were vaccinated outside the district.*
3. *Around two-thirds of residents aged 65 or more in Buffalo, Dawson and Kearney counties have been fully vaccinated; over a quarter of all eligible persons in Kearney, Gosper and Harlan counties have been fully vaccinated*
4. *Women account for a little short of 2/3<sup>rd</sup> of all fully vaccinated residents of TRPHD.*
5. *Two Rivers has scheduled mass vaccination clinics at multiple sites across the seven counties to distribute vaccines and to focus on areas of potential shortfall. Over 900 doses of vaccine are set to be offered to eligible residents over the next week. Those eligible for the vaccine are advised to contact their physician or register at Two Rivers Health Department ([www.trphd.org](http://www.trphd.org)).*
