



## County Information

Buffalo is the 2nd most populous county in Nebraska outside the Lincoln-Omaha region and home to the University of Nebraska Kearney campus. The proportion of people with a high school or college degree in Buffalo County is comparable to that of the whole state. Buffalo is also the 5th youngest county in Nebraska with a median age of 35 years. Yet, Buffalo is also home to the third highest number of assisted living/long term care facilities in Nebraska, after Douglas and Lancaster counties. The 3 largest cities in Buffalo County are Kearney (county seat), Gibbon and Ravenna.
