The All of Us Research Program is inviting 1 million people across the United States to help build one of the most diverse health databases in history. It is put on by the National Institute of Health, and the goal is to get as many people from all backgrounds, in our case rural, and use the data to learn how our biology, lifestyle, and environment affect health in the hopes of finding ways to prevent and treat disease. The goal of All of Us is to speed up health research discoveries, to enable new kinds of individualized health care.

This event will be happening August 7th – August 10th from 9:30 AM – 3 PM, at the Dawson County Annex Building located at 200 W 7th St, Lexington, NE 68850. By participating you can learn more about your health, including information about genetic traits and ancestry, potential increased risk of developing certain diseases, or how your body might react to certain medicines.
