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Learn More About Opportunities to Support Healthy Outdoor Spaces through TRPHD's New Nuisance Remediation Program

KEARNEY –Two Rivers Public Health Department is hosting a meeting to explore opportunities for local contractors to partner with TRPHD on grant-funded projects that improve healthy, safe, and functional outdoor spaces in our communities, including the new Nuisance to Nature (N2N) Program. Contractors with experience in junk removal, outbuilding repair, roofing, vegetation management, and pollinator garden installation are encouraged to attend to learn more about the program, contracting opportunities, project expectations, and how they can become involved. The meeting will be held on Friday, August 28, from 2:00-3:00 p.m. in the Loup Room at Kearney Public Library.

Through the N2N program, qualifying properties may receive assistance addressing issues such as accumulated refuse, deteriorated outbuildings, and overgrown vegetation, followed by the installation of a pollinator garden. Residents who are interested in the N2N program are also welcome to attend the meeting to learn more about the process and what services will be available.
